### **FLIXBUS (FL)**

provides intercity travel from Auburn to New Orleans, Biloxi, Mobile, Montgomery, & Atlanta.

### **GREYHOUND BUS (GB)**

provides nationwide, intercity bus service to/ from Opelika, Alabama.

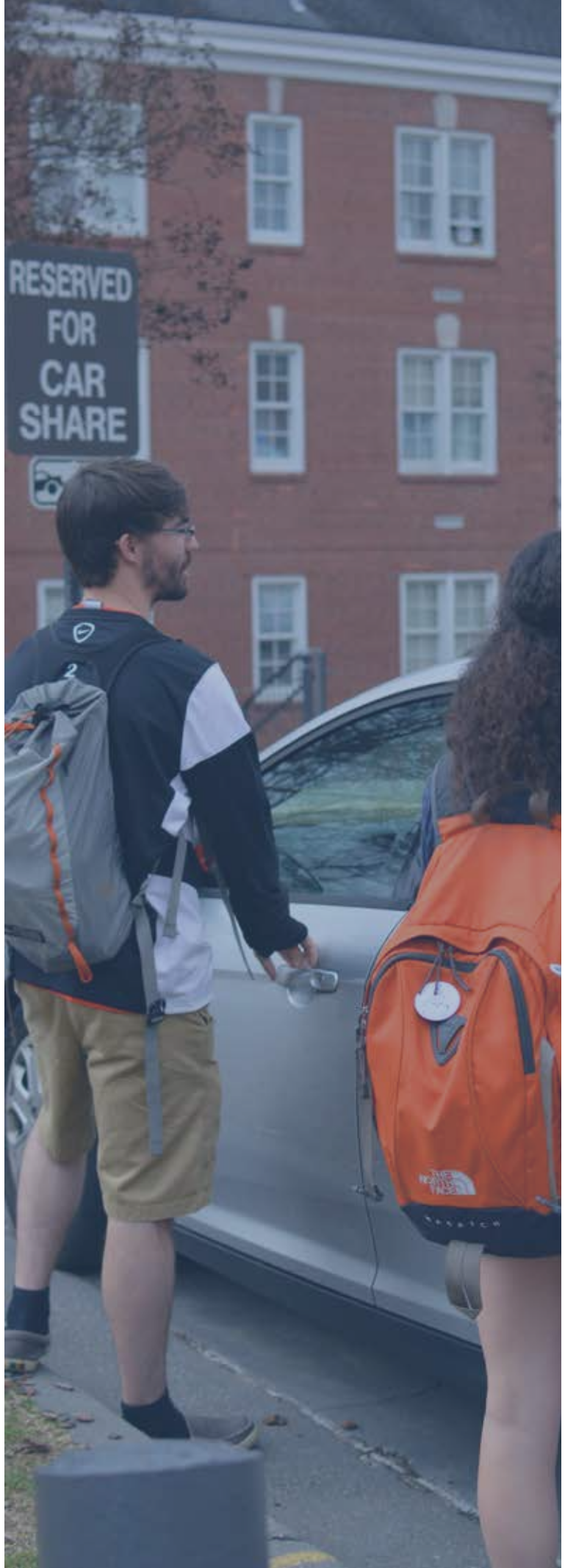
### **GROOME TRANSPORTATION (GT)**

offers reservation-based shuttle service with 20 round trips daily between Auburn & Atlanta's Hartsfield-Jackson International Airport.

### **RIDE AMIGOS RIDESHARE (RA)**

allows Auburn friends & classmates to set up one-time or regular carpool rides. Requires Auburn affiliation for participation.

# GETTING AROUND AUBURN

## BIKE

For a low-carbon & healthy way to get around try biking.

PERMIT your bike through Parking Services.

A **HELMET & LOCK** provide safety for you & your bike.

**SHOWERS** for bikers can be found around campus.

**BIKE RACKS** on all Tiger Transit buses make it easy to combine sustainable transportation modes.

The BIKE SHOP run by Auburn Outdoors can help you keep your ride in road-ready condition.

WAR EAGLE BIKE SHARE features pedal-assist bikes & e-scooters.

## ON CAMPUS

CAMPUS SECURITY SHUTTLE offers rides between on-campus destinations 7 days a week from 6 PM - 7 AM when classes are in session. Call 334-844-7400.

jAUnt provides free golf cart service within central campus for students/employees with a disability or medical condition. Request for service must be approved by the Office of Accessibility prior to scheduling. Call 334-707-2643.

WAR EAGLE EXPRESS serves as a free shuttle for students from residence halls to select on-campus dining venues & parking lots weekdays 6 - 10 PM, weekends 4 - 10 PM. Call 334-740-1436.

# GETTING AROUND AUBURN

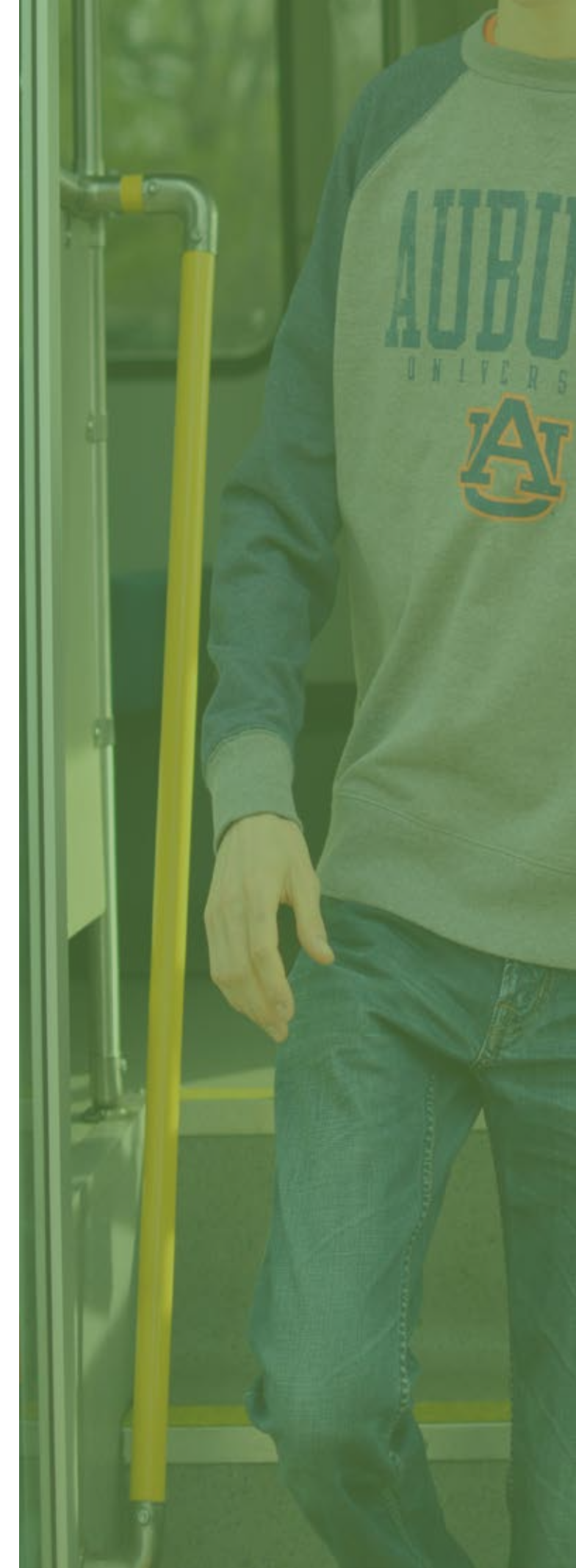
**TIGER TRANSIT** offers students bus service to destinations on & off campus. 20+ lines operate M - F from 7 AM - 8 PM (for most lines). A special Friday Evening Shopping Shuttle runs from 5:30 PM - 9:30 PM.

**AUBURN-LYFT LATE NIGHT SMART RIDE PROGRAM** ensures students can safely travel from campus to their on- or off-campus residence. Rides run on weekdays from the main Tiger Transit station 8 PM - 10 PM & from Toomer's Corner on Th - Sat from 10 PM until 3 AM. Visit [aub.ie/SafeRide](http://aub.ie/SafeRide) for details.

**LEE-RUSSELL PUBLIC TRANSIT** provides free curb-to-curb service within the Auburn/Opelika area to Auburn students, & free to/from campus service for employees. Fares for extended service costs \$3 - \$6 one way, & can take you as far as Phenix City. Service runs M - F, 6 AM - 6 PM, and trips must be scheduled at least 24 hours prior but may be scheduled up to 2 weeks in advance.

The **EMPLOYEE EXPRESS SHUTTLE** allows employees to get a ride to/from designated on-campus Tiger Transit spots, as well as select locations beyond campus such as the Fisheries Center & the Kreher Preserve & Nature Center. Call 334-844-8600.

**RIDE AMIGOS RIDESHARE** provides an online portal for arranging regular &/or one-time carpools. Users must be affiliated with Auburn University.
